

G-CANS FLOOD PREVENTION SYSTEM

Kasukabe City, Japan

G-Cans is the water collecting system part of a massive underground system intended to collect water in the greater Tokyo area in order to prevent floods. The G-Cans project works started in 1992 ; it consists of five concrete containment silos with a height of 65 m and a diameter of 32 m, connected by 6.4 km of tunnels, 50 m beneath the surface, as well as a large water tank with a height of 25.4m, with a length of 177m, with a width of 78m, and with 59 massive pillars connected to a number of 14,000 horsepower (10 MW) turbines that can pump up to 200 tons of water into the Edogawa river per second. The world's largest drain complex is also a tourist attraction, and can be visited for free. The main water tank has been used in movies and TV commercials to create futuristic or mystic scenes.

Shinkansen E4 Max-Yamabiko at Tokyo station. Shinkansen double-deck high speed train operates on the Tohoku and Jōhetsu Japan Railway lines at the maximum speed of 240 Km/h. In its extra-capacity configuration, with two eight-car sets coupled together, a sixteen-car E4 formation trainset carries a total of 1634 passengers - the highest-capacity high-speed rail trainset in the world..

La Tokyo Sky Tree est la plus haute structure du Japon, avec 634 mètres de hauteur, soit presque deux fois la hauteur de la Tour Eiffel. Le projet, conduit par un consortium regroupant le groupe Tobu Railway, six opérateurs de diffusion terrestre et la compagnie de diffusion NHK a un coût estimé à 65 milliards de yens (plus de 550 millions d'euros). Le chantier de construction attire dorénavant de nombreux visiteurs et les boutiques de souvenirs commencent à apparaître... Ouverture prévue : printemps 2012. Voici la Tokyo Sky Tree sur fond de ciel étoilé, avec les grues culminant à 497 mètres.
